<b>INSTRUMENT HEIGHT OR WIDTH</b>	The instrument is 20 centimeters tall or wide.	The instrument is less than 20 centimeters but more than 10 centimeters tall or wide.	The instrument is 10 centimeters or less tall or wide.	
<b>NUMBER OF MATERIALS USED</b>	The instrument is made of 5 or more different materials.	The instrument is made of 4-3 materials.	The instrument is made with 2 or fewer materials.	
<b>PLAYABILITY TEST</b>	The instrument is strong enough to be played for at least 30 seconds.	The instrument is strong enough to be played for 15-29 seconds.	The instrument is not strong enough to be played for more than 14 seconds.	
<b>DISTANCE TEST</b>	When played, instrument is able to be heard from at least 6 meters away.	When played, instrument is able to be heard from at 5-3 meters away.	When played, instrument cannot be heard over 3 meters away.	
<b>COUNTERS USED</b>	14 counters or less.	15 – 20 counters.	21 counters or more.	
<b>CHOREOGRAPHY</b>	Choreographed dance includes 5 or more moves.	Choreographed dance includes 1-4 moves.	There is no choreographed dance.	
<b>BONUS: NUMBER OF MATERIALS USED</b>	The instrument is made of 10 or more different materials.	The instrument is made of 7-9 materials.	The instrument is made 5 with or fewer materials.
